Description of the organisation

RENASUP is an institutional organisation gathering 515 Catholic Higher Education Schools, 62 000 students. It has a function of coordination and aims to improve the students' success. In relationship with the secondary catholic schools, RENASUP contributes to support vocational guidance.

RENASUP organises national meeting for sharing news and good practices. At regional level, it is managed by local links and at national level by a Forecasting and Research Group.

RENASUP signed agreements with various organisations, such as the CNAM (Conservatoire National des Arts et Métiers), APEL (Association des Parents de l'Enseignement Libre), EPA (Entreprendre pour Apprendre). It is also responsible for promoting partnerships across Europe as well as borders and works with UGSEL (an organisation to promote sport and education by means of sport in Catholic Schools).

RENASUP took part in several projects, as partner of the consortium:

- EUPROVET is a Leonardo project, which aim to promote ECVET and vocational education and training in EU;
- EQAVET is a project about quality assurance in vocational education and training;
- The School & Work aims at the prevention of early school leaving by creating a synergy between schools and the world of work.

RENASUP is in link with schools that develop Sport projects and usually works with UGSEL, which gathers headmasters and sport teachers to promote sport at school and health and social integration.
